About CHAS

CHAS is the Children's Hospice Association, Scotland. Our vision is that every baby, child and young person in Scotland will have access to palliative care when and where they need it. This sits at the heart of everything we do.

Our role as a charity is threefold.

- We provide **CARE** through our two wonderful hospices – Robin House in Balloch and Rachel House in Kinross – and also through CHAS at Home which has teams working from Robin House and Rachel House as well as dedicated teams in Aberdeen and Inverness, caring for families in their own homes when they need it most.
- We generate **SUPPORT** for our work through tireless, year-round fund-raising to secure over £9million, needed every year to run our hospices and provide services to families.
- We make **CONNECTIONS** between families, health and social care professionals, the media, supporters and influencers to raise awareness of our work and promote joined up service provision for families.

Caring for a child with a life-shortening condition can place unimaginable demands on families, physically and emotionally. Quite simply, we are here to lighten their load.



When you arrive



You will be welcomed at reception and shown to your room/s by a member of the team, who will help you settle in.

While you are staying you will be cared for by our care team which includes nurses, doctors and lots of other people who help support and look after you and your family.

We will have prepared your bedroom with you in mind. Your room is on the ground floor looking out onto the garden, with access to specially adapted bathrooms. Family bedrooms are downstairs with en suite facilities and a family lounge.



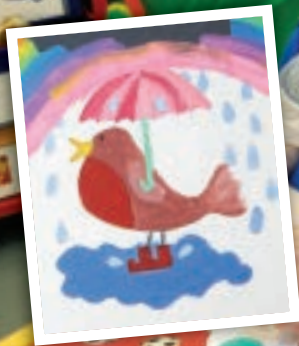


Lots to do
